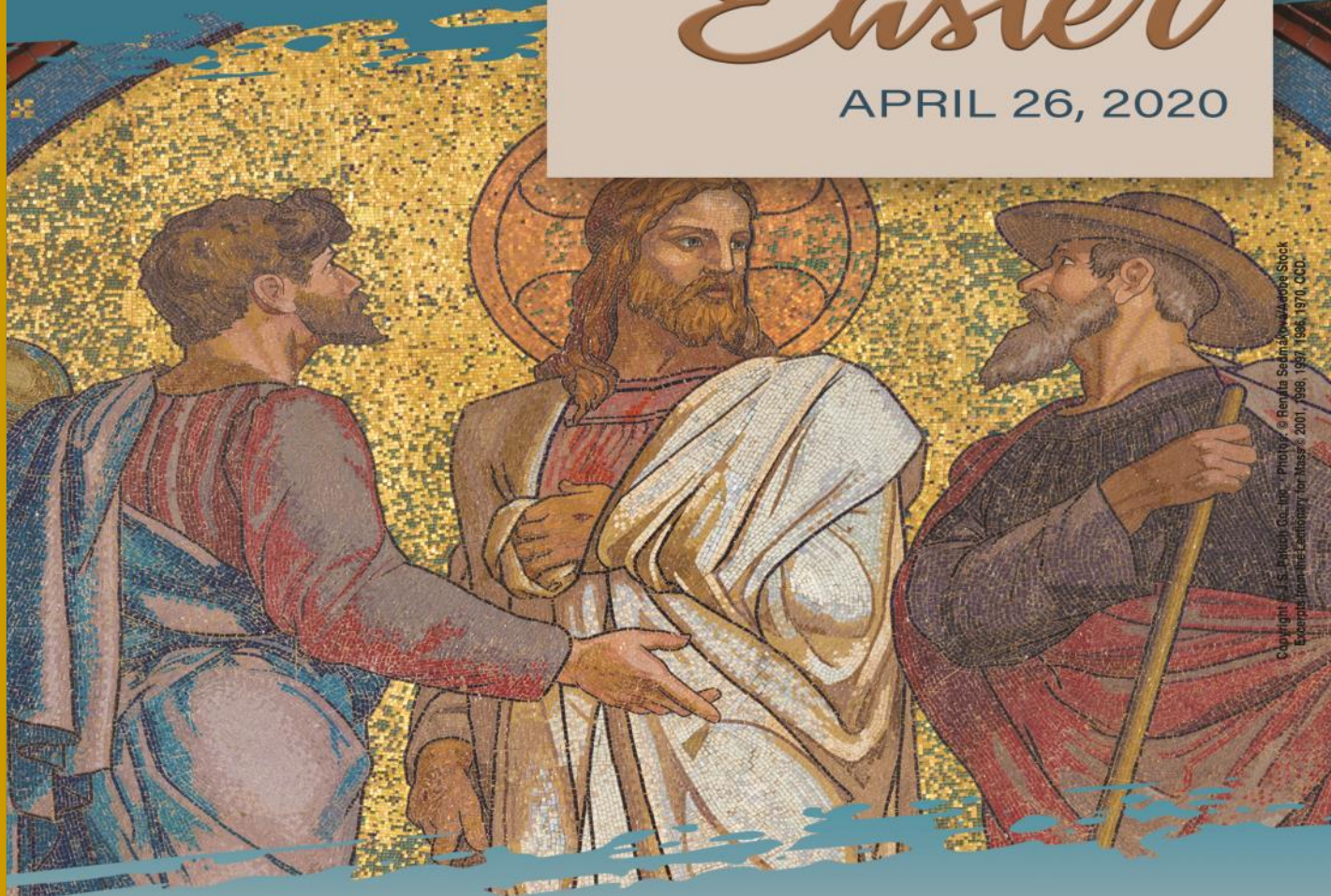

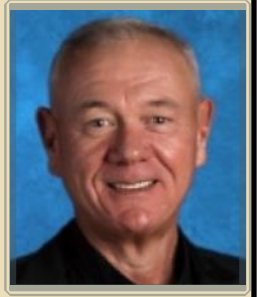

Our Challenge



Dear friends,

The sermon Peter preached at Pentecost interpreted the resurrection as God's final stamp of approval on the mission and message of Jesus. Jesus' enemies could not defeat him. Death could not hold him. God was revealed in the life of Jesus, and God was revealed in the death of Jesus by raising him to life. We place our faith and our hope in God because he raised Christ from the dead. We trust God to deliver us from the last enemy, which is death. We are sojourners in a strange land, but our home in heaven is secure. There is an important truth in the disciples' experience of the resurrected Jesus on the road to Emmaus. They did not recognize him until they broke bread together. The risen Christ is most powerfully present in the Eucharist. We encounter his saving power in the broken bread and the cup. It is interesting that Jesus was not always recognizable by his own disciples in his post-resurrection appearances. He was not merely a resuscitated corpse, but had a transformed body. Chiding them for being "slow of heart to believe," Jesus clearly expected them to recognize him despite the changes in his appearance. The promise of Christ's resurrection is that the ultimate outcome of the struggle between good and evil, life and death, has been decided. There are still struggles and conflicts, but we can live courageously because we know what the end will be. All courage does not have the same moral and spiritual value. Courage may be based on the hope of a reward, or the fear of punishment, or self-centered ambition. Moral courage functions without the promise of secondary gains and strictly on the basis of what is right, or of what is true. The disciples of Jesus Christ lived and died bravely because of their assurance of the final victory of good over evil and life over death.
