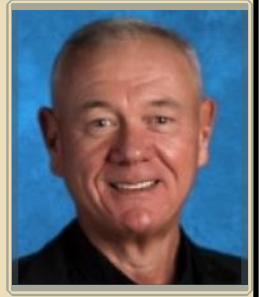

Our Challenge



Dear friends,

After the miracles of Pentecost, the followers of Christ undertook a communal manner of life. Those in need received what they needed. The people worshipped daily in the temple and broke bread in their homes. It was a beautiful example of faith and fellowship. The words in our second reading this weekend from the first letter of St. Peter were apparently a part of a sermon given as part of a baptismal ceremony. Rebirth through baptism is related to the resurrection of Christ. Faith will involve suffering, but in Christ the triumph of God is assured. The doubts of Thomas were not resolved until Jesus' post-resurrection appearance within the fellowship of the disciples Jesus provided Thomas the evidence he sought. Our own questions and doubts may be shared within the community of Christ's people. Faith is strengthened and grows best in the fellowship of the faithful. Unfortunately, "miracles" are synonymous in most people's minds with magic, supernatural phenomena, and a suspension of the laws of nature. This makes them easy to dismiss in the modern world. The miracles of Jesus, however, are full of meaning and insight that are far more important than the events themselves. The true miracle is an experience of transformation made possible by the love and power of God. People all around us need a miracle that restores the goodness and meaningfulness of life as revealed in Jesus Christ. Miracles do not always have an audience. Biblical miracles often had eyewitnesses, sometimes a multitude of them. But most miracles are personal, even private, experiences. Sometimes only the individual involved is aware of the miracle. Miracles are acts of God. To some they may be filled with mystery and confusion, but to us they are signs of God's redemptive purpose and loving care.

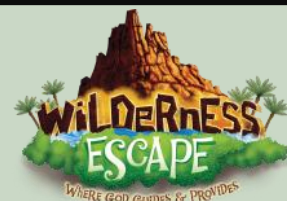

Our annual diocesan **Chrism Mass** which was originally scheduled to be at St. Joseph Cathedral this morning was not held, and will be rescheduled as soon as public Masses are again permitted.

Late-Breaking Cancellations and Postponements:

RCIA Rites of Baptism and Reception into Full Communion in the Catholic Church. Being unable to celebrate these rites at an Easter Vigil Mass this year, these rites have been postponed and will be rescheduled at another weekend Mass as soon as possible after public Masses resume.

Our **Servant Leadership Night** meetings of all our Commissions and Pastoral Council scheduled for April 28, 2020, has been cancelled, but virtual meetings are being planned by all our Commissions prior to a virtual meeting of the Pastoral Council on Monday evening, April 27, 2020.

Our Annual **Ministries Appreciation Event** – this year scheduled for Thursday, April 30, 2020, has been cancelled.

Because our **First Eucharist Afternoon of Reflection & Parent Meeting** scheduled on Sunday, March 22, 2020, had to be canceled, parents and children will participate and complete from home in a soon-to-be-released on-line version.

Our **First Communion Weekend** this year was to be May 2-3, 2020. First Communions have been postponed and parents will be receiving information and re-scheduling our First Communions as soon as possible after public Masses resume. Parents will receive messages from Fr. Randy and our Children Formation Director, Mrs. Tricia Greely, explaining how they will be handled.

Our **Neighborfest** event in Valley Park scheduled for Saturday, May 30, 2020, has been cancelled.

April's **Baptism Seminar** has been cancelled and an [on-line Baptism Class](#) for first-time parents and godparents has been developed and is now available at our [website](#). Upon completion of the on-line version, parents and godparents can print and submit a certificate of completion.

Our parish's **Pastoral Council** has been meeting virtually with Father Ryan and I every Monday, and providing wonderful reports of so many of our parish ministries remaining engaged and connected in this difficult time. I really appreciate their hard work, wise counsel and recommendations!

In your physical absence, we've been able to keep our Church staff working to keep our office operating, our ministries and parishioners connected, and our beautiful church and facilities operating and in good shape for whenever public Masses can resume and everything will be open again.

In my 'update' message of March 20, 2020, I said a little something about commitments to our **Stewardship of Offering to St. Aloysius**, which was prior to knowing that we'd be without public Masses indefinitely. So, I've been asked to summarily repeat that 'plug' again. I'm aware that with each passing day, many of our families are hard-hit by the temporary severity of the market drop and curtailment of their income livelihoods. If any become hard-pressed for necessities, do contact me personally. We are deeply grateful to many who...even in the midst of all their own personal anxieties and uncertainties...have reached out with concern for St. Aloysius, its staff, and its financial solvency. Without weekend Masses and the accompanying collections, our challenges and budget adjustments will not be unlike the challenges many of our parishioners will be facing. We are very blessed that so many of our regular givers utilize twice-monthly ACH automated bank draft or EFT for their charitable contributions to our parish. 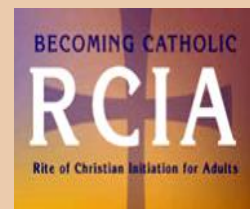

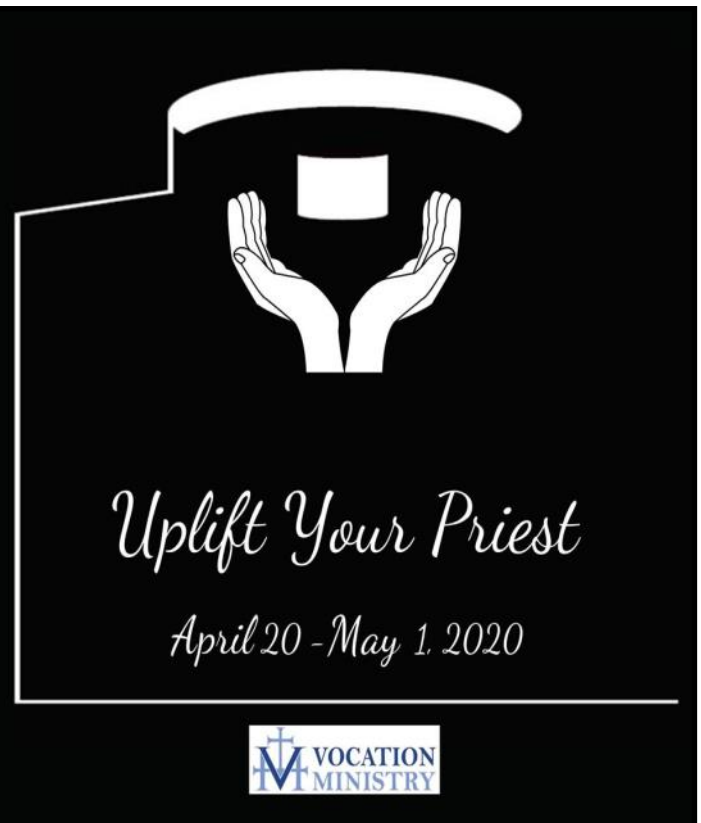

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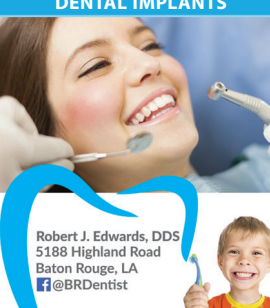
