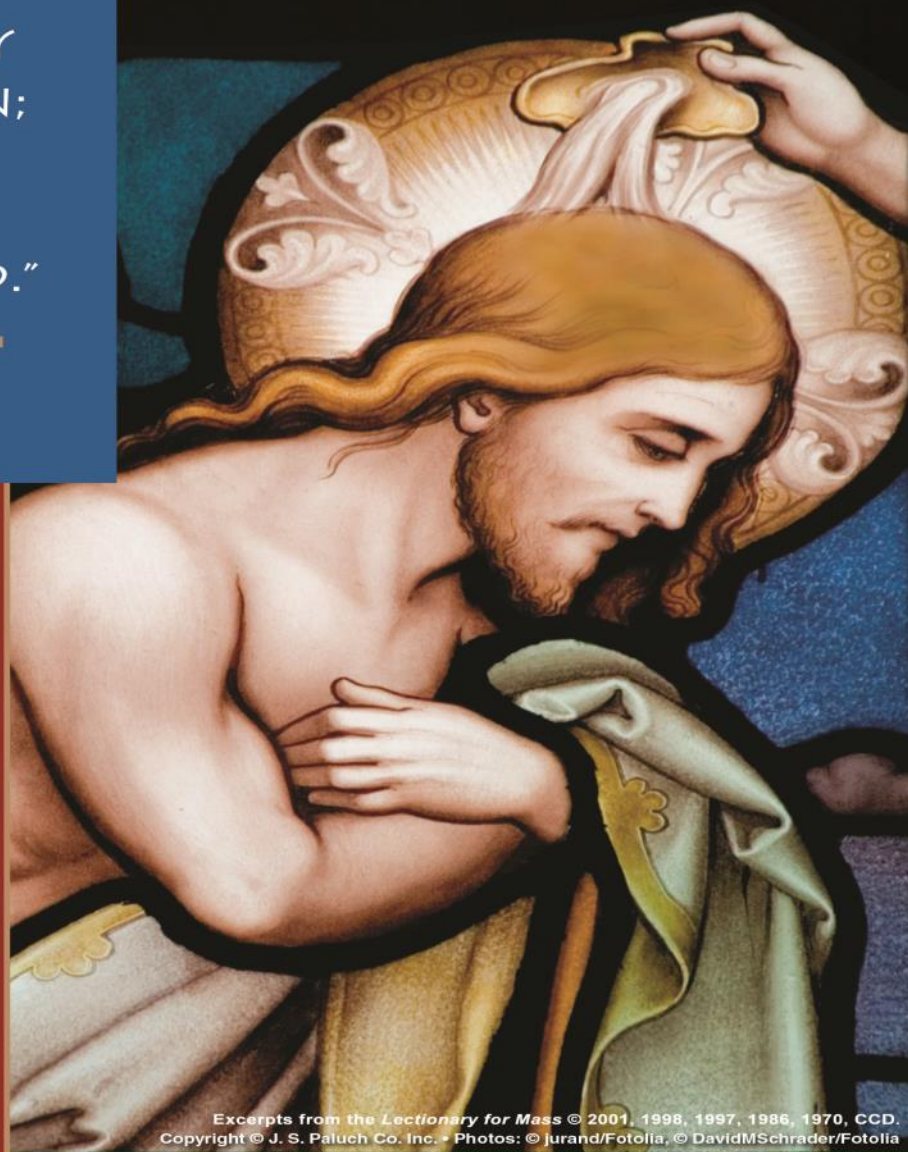

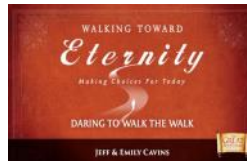

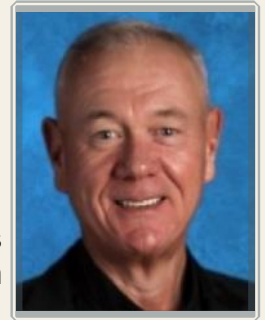
Our Challenge

Dear friends,

The prophets of ancient Israel lived with their feet on the ground but their heads in the sky. They looked forward to a time when God's Servant would bring forth justice among the nations, free the captives, and bring light to those in darkness. Like the other disciples of Jesus, Peter originally believed that the good news of Christ's coming was only for the Jews. But a vision from heaven convinced him that the gospel was for all nations and all races. Peter was willing to let go of the past for the sake of the future. Again and again great moments and movements in history only prepare the way for what is to come. John the Baptist stirred the people with his preaching like the prophets of old. But John was only a stepping-stone for the arrival of the Messiah. The "old oaken bucket syndrome" is how some psychologists label those who live in the past. These are the people whose lives are miserable because their present circumstances do not measure up to their past achievements. While we must never forget the past, we have to let go of it or we will have no future. It is easy to get stuck in life where we are, particularly if things are comfortable and familiar. But life clutched too tightly has a way of going dead on us. Every parent understands that babies will take a few falls when learning to walk. Wise parents know there is a positive side to this. Children will never learn to stand on their own two feet if someone is always holding on to them. God treats us the same way. Like a mother eagle who breaks up the nest to force her eaglets to fly, so God stirs life up to compel us to move ahead.

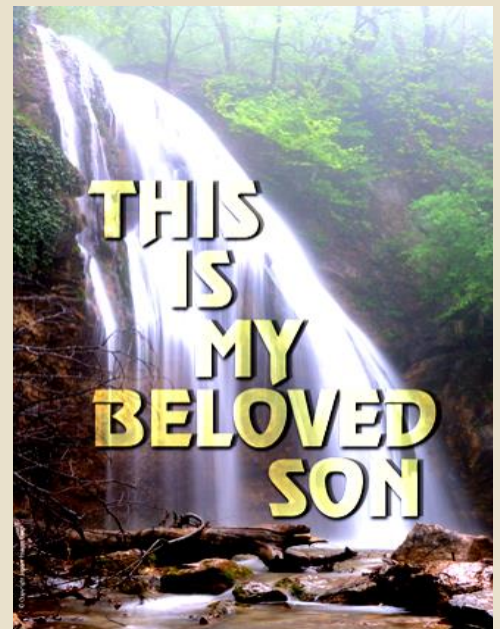

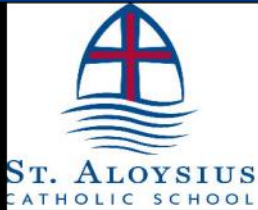

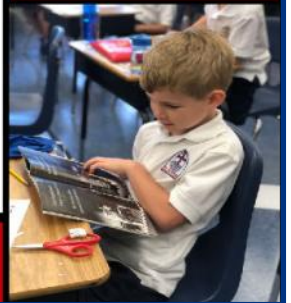

Adult Confirmation classes will be held from 6:30– 8:00PM on **February 8, February 22, March 8, March 22, April 5, April 19, and May 3**. Presently, only virtual meetings can be planned. If circumstances permit, registrants will be informed that the meetings will be conducted in person.
