Engaged couples should contact the priest at least six months prior to their anticipated wedding date.

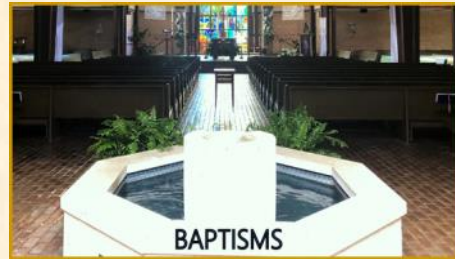

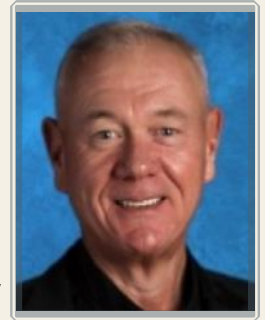

Our Challenge

Dear friends,

In the Old Testament, God made a promise to Noah and his family that he would never again destroy the world by flood. But he did not promise that his people would be protected from dark clouds and heavy rainstorms. Rather, with every test he promised a rainbow of hope. Don't think for a minute that God picks on you or allows you to suffer because you are sinful. The only perfect human being who ever lived was tested by suffering and evil just as we are. Being put to the test goes with the territory of being a child of God. In our New Testament's first letter of St. Peter, his promise to the faithful has a double edge. We must deny ourselves to fulfill ourselves. We must suffer defeat to achieve success. This paradox is embedded in the sacrament of baptism where we die with Jesus in order to be raised with Him. Life can be compared to an athletic contest in several ways. Like every sporting event, life puts us to the test. It calls for our best efforts under challenging conditions. But life also puts us to the test on offense as well as defense. It challenges our productivity as well as our endurance. We can tell if we need to take concrete measures to strengthen our faith if we find ourselves blaming or doubting God when trouble or losses come. Nothing in the Bible suggests that the people of God are spared the fears and fires of life. But the Bible does promise us that God will help us face every test with courage and patience. We dare not measure our faithfulness by such yardsticks as good health, grand wealth, or even great wisdom. The quality of our lives is revealed in how well we cope with adversities and shortcomings. We can judge the strength of our faith more by the losses we have endured than by the wins we have scored.

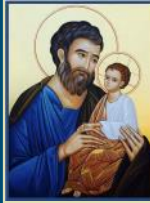
