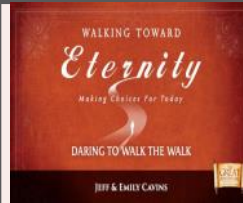

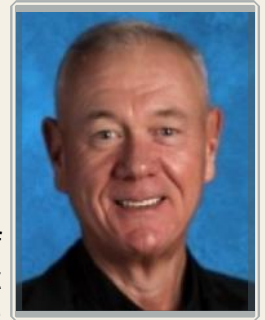
## Our Challenge

Dear friends,

Isaiah the prophet prayed that God would redeem and restore the people, even if it took earthquakes and violence to get their attention. But God is always present in our lives, either as the structure against which we are broken or as the foundation on which we stand. Like all early Christians, the Apostle Paul expected Christ to return to the earth in power and glory. He also believed Christ was a living presence strengthening the people day by day. The Christ who will come is the Christ who is ever present. Jesus urged his disciples to watch for the end-time. He did not mean we are to forget the lessons of the past or ignore the duties of the present. Jesus meant we should live in such a way that our lives are in order no matter what happens to us. Where is Christ in the world today? Some people find him in beautiful stained-glass windows or elegant statuary. Others find him in sacred music and ritual dramas. But Christ is not limited to our religious institutions and celebrations. He is present in every human face and in every genuine expression of love. How do we prepare for the coming of Christ? The best preparation for tomorrow is to faithfully meet today's responsibilities. If we meet the challenges immediately before us, we will be better prepared for the future. The One who comes at Christmas seeks the lost and the least. The season of Advent is a good time to ask ourselves who are the forgotten people in our lives. Where would Christ go first in your neighborhood or city? Putting Christ in Christmas might mean going to those who most need his love and care. Honoring Christ at Christmas might mean rescuing the forgotten and lifting up the fallen. In as much as we show love to the lost and the least we show love to him.

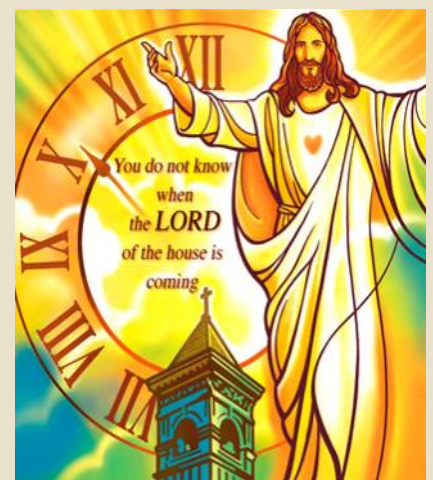

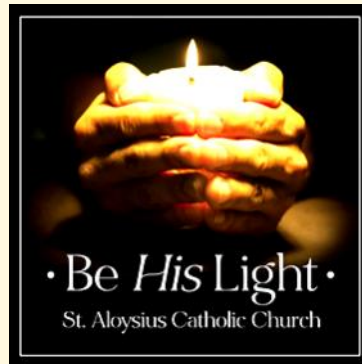

## Stewardship of Prayer Weekend: December 5-6, 2020



### Cultivating Prayer Life in Order to Be His Light

Next week, as part of the Stewardship of Prayer, parishioners will receive a letter from Fr. Randy on prayer, an important element of spiritual stewardship. The letter will include a prayer commitment card containing a variety of prayer methods that each parishioner can pledge to incorporate into his or her prayer life. Regardless of how we each choose to pray, God grants us many opportunities to seek His help and direction throughout each day.

The very first Psalm reminds us that *"Blessed is the man... [for whom] the law of the Lord is his joy; and on his law he meditates day and night. He is like a tree planted near streams of water, that yields its fruit in season; its leaves never wither; whatever he does prospers."* (Psalm 1: 1-3). Let us root ourselves through daily prayer and His word so that we, too, may yield spiritual fruit. Sallie Latkovich, CSJ, wrote this beautiful prayer that highlights how prayer can nourish our lives:

*"Come, Lord Jesus.  
I open my mind and heart and soul,  
and long for You to be born anew in me.  
Help me to experience Your presence within me,  
and to allow You to touch the earth through me. Amen."*

In order for us to "Be His Light", we need to be able to hear His voice clearly. Cultivating an active prayer life helps us to do this. Let us all work to grow our prayer practices in the coming year so that we can "Be His Light" in every area of our lives.
