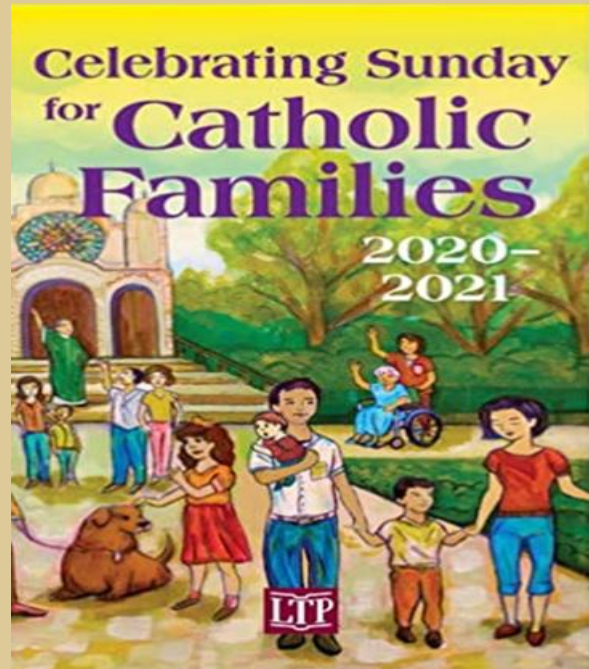

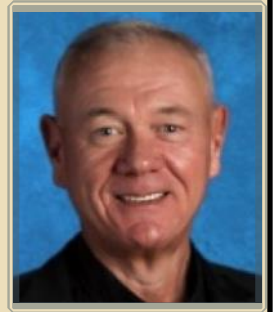
Our Challenge

Dear friends:

The prophet Jeremiah felt duped by the Lord. He believed that being a prophet would fill his life with high adventure and great happiness. Instead he discovered that serving God brought him no end of troubles. Contrary to some theologians, Christ's death on the cross did not mean an end to sacrificial worship. To be sure, his death did take away the need to sacrifice animals. But his crucifixion confirmed God's unyielding demand that we sacrifice ourselves. It took a while for the disciples to catch on to the mission of Jesus. They had always believed that the Messiah would crush the forces of evil rather than be crushed by them. Jesus showed them that suffering love is the only way to conquer the world's evil. A religious symbol like the cross does more than remind us of an event in the distant past. The cross also points us to a vital dimension of reality in the present. The cross reveals that God's love for us and our love for one another are costly every day and in every age. The only way to minimize life's pain is to seal ourselves off from other people. We cannot enjoy the pleasures while ignoring the problems of others. Loving and being loved opens us up to love's risks and costs. There are two kinds of people at the cross - - - those who drive the nails and those who endure the pain. We are one or the other. We either enlarge the world's suffering or we help carry the world's pain. We either crucify the world in spiteful hate or change the world through suffering love.

- Before Mass, Wash your hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer.

- After Mass, depart row by row from the rear, moving forward.

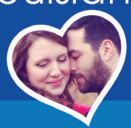
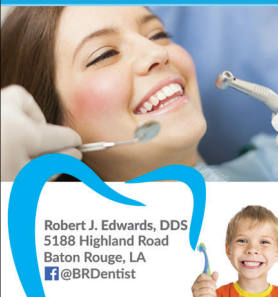
