Adult Confirmation is hosted annually. For those under 18, Confirmation typically occurs in the fall of their junior year of high school. Preparation is required, including PSR, for teens not enrolled in a Catholic school. Please contact the Pastoral Services Center for more detailed information.

Baptism & Confirmation sponsors must be Confirmed, practicing Catholics and will need to provide a letter of good standing from the parish in which they are registered.

MARRIAGE

Engaged couples should contact the priest at least six months prior to their anticipated wedding date.

Our Challenge

Dear friends,

We often feel that we have a hard time in life. The sage who wrote the book of Wisdom, however, reminds us that we have it better than we deserve. God governs our world in leniency, and attends to our lives in love. No matter how hard our lives become, we have the promise of the apostle Paul that we are not alone. The Spirit of God helps us with our weakness. The Spirit identifies with our sorrow. The Spirit intercedes for us in our prayers. The Spirit knows our hearts and lifts our spirits. In this weekend's gospel passage, we hear a parable from Jesus that tells us how to live in an imperfect world. We may be surrounded by lies and hate, we may be threatened by violence and death. But if we cultivate the fragile plants of truth and love, if we seek the goals of peace and freedom, our world may become a garden, not a jungle. Who of us would not change things if we could? We wish for a world in which issues are clear cut. We want things to be either good or bad, true or false, right or wrong. It is not to be in this life. Life is filled with ambiguity, therefore the mark of faith and of reason is to make the best of things as they are. God offers us strength for this. Our God-given task is not to make the world perfect, but to cultivate truth, beauty, and goodness - - leaving the harvest up to God. When thinking about taking life as it comes, the well-known Serenity Prayer comes readily to mind: "O God, grant me the serenity to accept the things I cannot change, the courage to change the things I can, and the wisdom to know the difference." Often missed by that prayer, connected with 'the things' is the important clarification: 'the things about myself.'

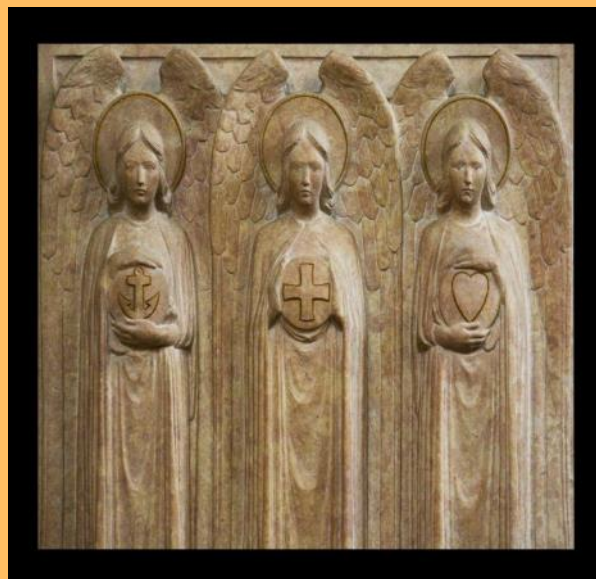

The St. Aloysius Stephen Ministry continues to



serve our caregivers in the parish in providing one-to-one, Christ-centered care to people experiencing life

difficulties, losses and transitions. Because the key role of Stephen Ministers is to visit and offer one-to-one care to their care recipients, the pandemic has made it very challenging to meet in such a personal way. The Stephen Ministry members are digitally, by phone, and/or private visits by observing social distancing visitations, accordingly to the desires of the care recipient. The ministry will abide by the Governor's orders, (which the Diocese of Baton Rouge also follows), as well as the current CDC guidelines to ensure the safety and well-being of its members and those recipients of whom they are visiting.

The St. Aloysius Stephen Ministry is a lay ministry that supplements pastoral care. The program teaches lay persons to provide one-on-one care to individuals facing a variety of crises or life challenges, such as hospitalization, chronic illness, job loss, grief, divorce, cancer, financial difficulties or other life struggles.

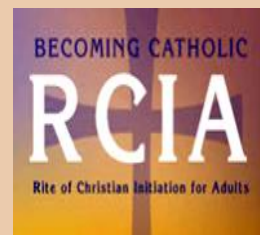

[WATCH VIDEO](#)

When Celebrating the Eucharist in person:

- ◆ Before Mass, Wash your hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer.
- ◆ Face masks are required on campus.
- ◆ Be seated in the available pews filling from front to rear.
- ◆ Ushers will direct you.
- ◆ You may share a pew with your household, but a 6 ft distance is required between households or individuals.
- ◆ Please, no holding hands during the Lord's Prayer. Offer the Sign of Peace without touching by using a bow, wave or other kind gesture.
- ◆ Holy Communion will be received in the hand.
- ◆ After Mass, depart row by row from the rear, moving forward.
- ◆ Please depart the church immediately.
