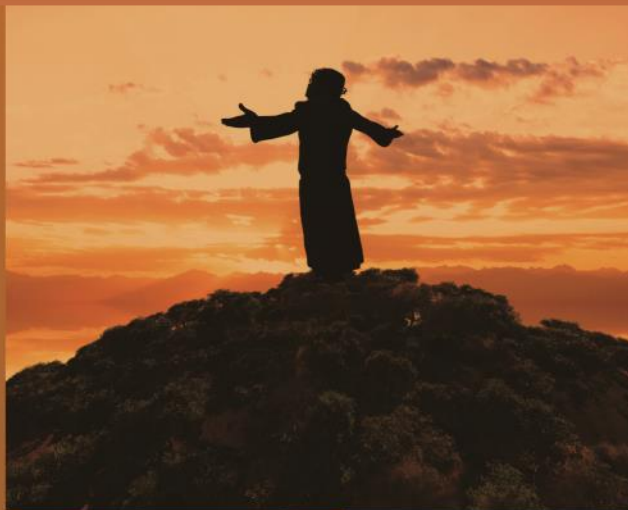

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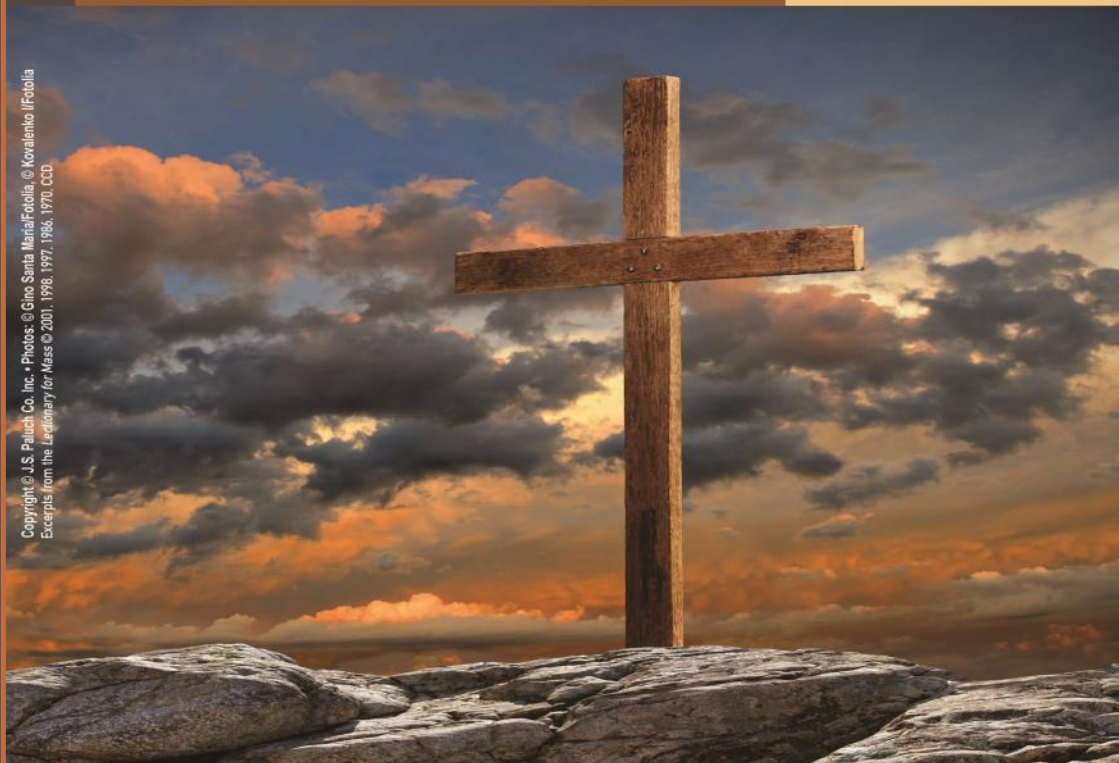

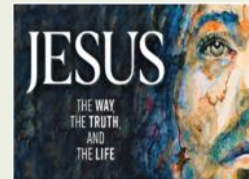
CARE OF THE SICK

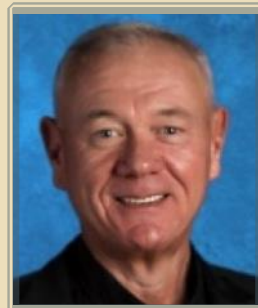
Our Challenge

Dear friends:

The Old Testament is full of reminders of how foolish it is for humanity to think that it is in control of its history. God is involved in everything from the rise and fall of empires to the waxing and waning of prosperity. God finally is the power that both wounds us and blesses us. St. Paul wrote to the earliest Christians in Rome to remind them that there is no more radical faith than a belief in one God. There are no powers above or alongside of God. No matter how opaque and oppressive life becomes, finally all things are from God, and through God, and for God. It was no surprise that even those who saw and heard Jesus face-to-face on earth missed who he was and what he did. Some saw him as a prophet, others as an imposter. But Simon Peter recognized him as the Revealer of true humanity and true divinity. No one can ignore the historical fact of Jesus of Nazareth. People have very different ideas about who he really was and what he accomplished. To his followers, he was the Son of God and Savior of the world. To his enemies, he was a revolutionary and a heretic. But who is Jesus Christ, really, for us? Jesus Christ not only reveals who God is, but he also reveals who we are. We see in Jesus Christ the kind of creatures we were made to be - - radically and totally loving God and loving others. We think of Christ as more a matter of our deeds than our creeds. We can be ever so orthodox in our beliefs and ever so pagan in our actions. We prove that we understand who Christ is and what he does when we emulate his love for God and his love for every person.

St. Aloysius Catholic Church / Facilities Manager *(Full-time position)*

General Statement of Duties

The Facilities Manager is responsible for the optimal operational condition, attractive appearance, and safety of the physical plant and infrastructure – buildings, grounds, equipment, machinery, systems, etc. -- of all Church-owned properties (i.e. church, school, childcare center, etc.). In consultation with the Facilities Maintenance Committee and Church Finance Council as needed, and approval of the Pastor: plans, acquires estimates, budgets, schedules, and implements labor, materials and/or contracts for required repairs & long-range preventive maintenance to maintain the physical plant and infrastructure in ongoing optimal condition and appearance.

In collaboration with the Chair of the Facilities Maintenance Committee, schedules and arranges for regular meetings of the Committee and actively engages the expertise, skills, and resources of its members toward realizing the mission of the Church and accomplishing the position duties. Hires, supervises, terminates maintenance and custodial support staff in accord with all Church and diocesan policies and civil government laws and standards.

Education and Experience Requirements

- High School Graduate or equivalent and minimum of three to five years related experience with training certification(s) consistent with the standards of plant management required;
- Associates Degree, two-year college, or equivalent preferred.
- Current and knowledgeable and/or experienced in the areas of plumbing, HVAC, electrical/lighting, carpentry, welding, personnel management, and general physical plant management.
- Must possess current driver's license.
- Capable of bearing responsibility for the upkeep of all church-owned grounds.

Other Requirements

- Attention to detail, accuracy, analytical and problem solving skills required
- Working knowledge of computer, MS Office, and ability to learn software systems and work-order management software
- Strong interpersonal skills essential
- Ability to exercise good organizational and time management skills
- Ability to manage projects and multiple priorities
- Ability to work with staff and parishioners
- Ability to lift 75 lbs.

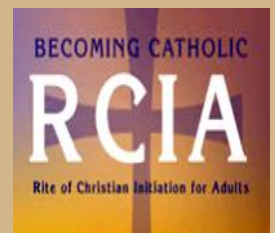

When Celebrating the Eucharist in person:

- Before Mass, Wash your hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer.
- Face masks are required on campus.
- Be seated in the available pews filling from front to rear.
- Ushers will direct you.
- You may share a pew with your household, but a 6 ft distance is required between households or individuals.
- Please, no holding hands during the Lord's Prayer. Offer the Sign of Peace without touching by using a bow, wave or other kind gesture.
- Holy Communion will be received in the hand.
- After Mass, depart row by row from the rear, moving forward.
- Please depart the church immediately.

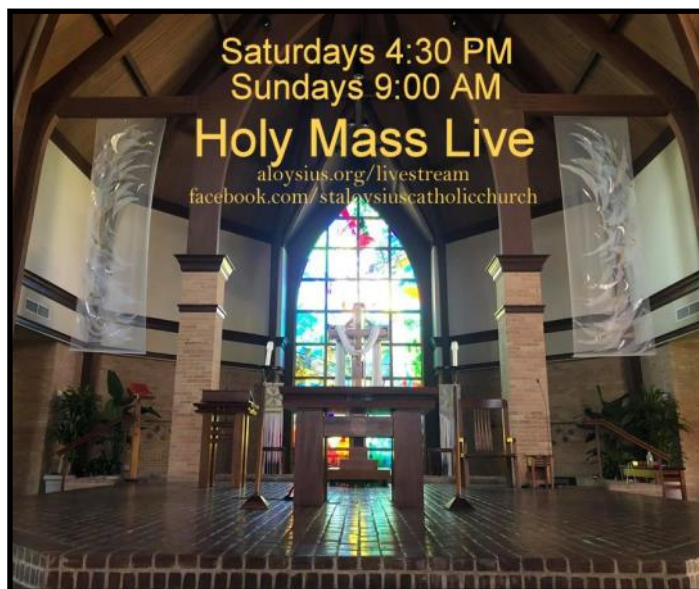

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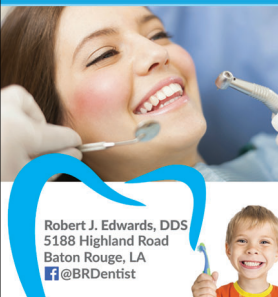
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
